STEP 2: Find Wildlife
Spot and observe plant and animal life in and around your home environment or neighborhood.

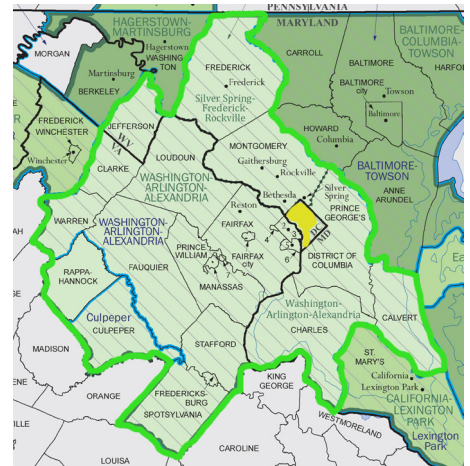
STEP 3: Photograph What You Find
