



Educational Programs Internship Fall 2026

Tudor Place Historic House & Garden seeks qualified applicants for its education internship program. The program is designed to provide research opportunities and practical, hands-on experience to students pursuing a degree in museum studies, museum education, American history, public history, art history, architectural history, library science or archival studies.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Develop two to three activities for outreach opportunities under supervision of the Education Coordinator and Director of Education & Visitor Services
- Work alongside the Visitor Services Manager to create accessibility material for the historic site
- Assist in planning programs for fall (including Trick or Treat at Tudor Place and December holiday programs)
- Facilitate Girl Scout and Tudor Tots programs, school field trips and family programs under the supervision of the Education Coordinator
- Lead private and public tours of the historic house and garden
- Attend training sessions and ongoing program meetings as needed
- Perform administrative tasks as needed

Qualifications:

- Enrollment in a relevant graduate-level degree program; strong undergraduate applicants may be considered
- Excellent written and oral communication skills
- Excellent organizational skills and attention to detail
- Strength, dexterity and mobility to perform all duties
- Public speaking skills; prior experience leading tours a plus
- Prior experience working with educational programs and special events a plus

Schedule & Logistics:

- Approximately 21 hours/week with a flexible schedule Tuesday-Friday, along with evening or weekend hours depending on availability; total number of hours dependent on credit requirements of the student's academic institution if credit is being sought for the internship
- Approximate dates of internship are September 8, 2026 – December 11, 2026
- Work will primarily be in person at Tudor Place, although some allowances may be made for remote work
- Interns are eligible to receive a Museum Shop discount and free on-site parking
